# This week:

- Join Twitter; read tutorial materials from the internet; follow 5 TEFL educators

- Send a follow-up e-mail to the presenter I met at the TEFL conference last week

- Write my first Tweet

- Present a "Lunch and Learn" session on how to increase the amount of listening activities in the intermediate curriculum
